POWER LISTENING STRATEGY OVERVIEW

- **P** PREVIEW and think about the material
 - 1. Scan the chapter. Look at the:
 - title
 - headings
 - subheadings
 - chapter summary
 - illustrations, charts, graphs
 - 2. Think: What is your opinion about what you are about to read? Some things to think about:
 - What do you think the topic of the reading is?
 - Do you know anything about what you are about to read?
 - How difficult do you think the material will be to understand? Why?
 - How long do you think it will take you to complete?
 - How interesting does the material look?
- **O** ORGANIZE your note taking materials
 - 1. Turn titles, headings and subheadings into questions.
 - 2. Record them on your POWER note taking organizer

- W WONDER– what is it all about? Listen and summarize
 - 1. Listen to a portion of the material.
 - 2. Turn off the playback device.
 - 3. Summarize the material you just listened to.
 - 4. Record the summary on your POWER note taking organizer.
 - 5. Describe any graphics that support your summary.
 - 6. Repeat steps 1-5 until you complete the passage.
- **E** EVALUATE your understanding by answering the questions
 - Answer the subtitle questions.
 - Answer the chapter question.
- **R** REVIEW any questions you missed
 - 1. If you miss a question, re-listen to the material.
 - 2. Write down any new summaries that help you answer the questions.
 - 3. Study your notes!
